# How do I subscribe to an NCTM Journal?

NCTM members received Mathematics Teacher: Learning and Teaching PK-12 (MTLT) as a member benefit. Premium members receive MTLT in addition to Journal of Mathematics Research in Education (JRME) and Mathematics Teacher Educator (MTE). Subscribers purchasing a print + online subscription will receive the next print issue and be granted access to the journal's online content after the order is successfully processed. Subscribers purchasing an MTE subscription will have access after the order has been fully processed.

NCTM does not charge submission or article publication fees.

# After my manuscript is accepted, can I reuse my manuscript or portions without seeking permission from NCTM?

Although authors of manuscripts accepted for publication must transfer copyright to NCTM, the authors reserve explicit rights to reuse their work, granted acknowledgment is noted and the proper version of the manuscript is used. To learn more, visit the Copyright and Permissions page.

### How do I submit a book proposal or manuscript to NCTM?

Authors should submit proposals and full manuscripts by using our automated system, <u>Manuscript Central:</u>

Librarian administrators can manage their institution's account via the AMS. To access the AMS, please visit https://ams.nctmpubs.org. Log in with your username and password. Your username is the e-mail on record with your account (if you need help locating your username, contact us). Upon accessing the AMS for the first time, you will need to set a password; set your password by entering your username and clicking on "Forgot your password?". You will receive an e-mail to reset your password and log in to your account.
